By-laws REVISED May 2018

Article I Name

San Andreas Movers and Shakers...it's not our fault, a non profit, unincorporated support group (formed under the ProActive Parkinson's Project) hereafter referred to as "S.A.M.S."

Article II Purpose

Our mission is to encourage a respectful and compassionate environment within our community for people with Parkinson's and other neurological diseases and their caregivers, families and friends, through education, advocacy and support.

Article III Policy

It shall be the policy of this group to provide a comfortable and friendly meeting to support and comfort our friends.

Article IV Membership

Any person interested in promoting the objectives of the organization shall become a member. No dues are required. Donations are acceptable.

Article V Officers and Duties

PRESIDENT:

Shall preside over the meetings of the organization and the Executive Board and is a member ex-officio of all regular and special committees and appoints standing committee Chairpersons.

VICE PRESIDENT:

Shall perform the duties of the President in his/her absence or at the request of the President.

TREASURER:

Shall keep a record of the funds donated through the Calaveras Community Foundation, and request funds when needed and be the Director of the funds.

Shall hold the positions of Acting President and Vice President of the ProActive Parkinson's Project with signature authority over funds.

Shall submit an annual report to the Executive Board at the meeting in November.

Treasurer is allowed to spend up to \$200.00 without Board approval.

SECRETARY:

Shall keep a record of Executive Board minutes, communications and publicity.

Article VI Executive Board / Standing Committee

The Executive Board will consist of four members:

President, Vice – President, Secretary and Treasurer

The standing committee will consist of three members appointed by the President:

Program Coordinator, Refreshment/Hospitality Chairperson and Membership Chairperson.

The Executive Board shall meet twice a year and shall fix the time and place of meetings.

Article VII Meetings

Meetings will be held on the first Tuesday of every month, from 10:00 am to 12 Noon at the Calaveras County Main Library 1299 Gold Hunter Road, San Andreas, California.

Article VIII Funds

Monies donated to the group will be deposited into the non-profit 501(c)3 Calaveras Community Foundation and they will monitor the funds, and disburse when necessary.

Article IX Elections

Nominations for Officers will take place at the November meeting and the Nominee's names will be posted.

The Officers will be elected by a majority vote of the membership present at the January meeting by a show of hands.
